Form 1099-G Available Online for Unemployment Compensation Beneficiaries

MONTGOMERY -- Unemployment compensation beneficiaries can now access important tax reporting information for calendar year 2013.

Claimants can now view and print their 2013 Form 1099-G from the Alabama Department of Labor's website at www.labor.alabama.gov. In addition to the 2013 Form 1099-G, years 2010-2012 are also available online.

The Form 1099-G details how much unemployment compensation claimants received during the calendar year as well as information about taxes withheld from unemployment benefits. This information must be reported each year.

Claimants have the opportunity to view and print the 2013 Form 1099-G online before the form will be printed and mailed. If a claimant views his or her Form 1099-G online prior to the print version being processed the printed version will **not** be mailed to the claimant.

The print version of the Form 1099 will begin being processed on Jan. 15 and will be mailed out no later than Jan. 31.
