SUBJECT: State's Average Weekly Wage

On May 12, 2023, in accordance with the provision of Section 25-5-68(c), <u>Code of Alabama 1975</u>, as last amended, the Secretary of Labor determined that the State's average weekly wage for calendar year <u>2022</u> was <u>\$1,084.38</u>.

For injuries occurring on and after July 1, 2023, the maximum workers' compensation payable will be \$1,084.00 per week, and the minimum compensation will be \$298.00 per week.

Please advise the appropriate personnel in your organization of these changes.

Previous years' maximum and minimum compensation payable as provided under Section 25-5-68 are as follows:
