## DISASTER UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE FOR QUALIFIED UNEMPLOYED WORKERS IN THREE COUNTIES

MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA, July 12, 2005 . . . . . Unemployed workers in Escambia County, an additional county declared as a disaster area due to Hurricane Dennis, may be eligible for benefits under the Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA) program. Baldwin County and Mobile County had previously been declared disaster areas.

“DUA benefits are available to persons who work or live in those counties and became unemployed, or could not engage in their customary self-employment, as a direct result of Hurricane Dennis,” says Phyllis Kennedy, director of the Alabama Department of Industrial Relations.

Claims for state unemployment compensation (UC) benefits may be filed by calling 1-866-234-5382. Generally, persons who are eligible for state unemployment benefits are not eligible for DUA, but the claimant may qualify for DUA if state UC benefits are exhausted. Self-employed individuals will be requested to provide a copy of their 2004 income tax records. **The final date to file a claim in Escambia County is August 11. The final date to file a claim in Baldwin County and Mobile County is August 10, 2005.**

DUA services are administered by the Alabama Department of Industrial Relations through its network of four Unemployment Compensation Call Centers across the state. Funding is provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
